Hill Top School Criteria for Entry to Sixth Form

Criteria

1

Student will have a substantial need to continue to progress in core subjects (usually achievement is below Level 1 in either Literacy or Maths or both by end of KS4).

2

Student's behaviour is acceptable and student will be able to continue to show a positive, willing attitude.

3

Student's attendance is acceptable and does not have a negative impact on their progress and results.

4

Student is unable to access
FE courses to suit their
ability and interests. They
therefore need longer time
at school to enable them
to achieve the
qualifications needed.

5

Student's level of social interaction/life skills are limited and therefore needs more nurturing time before going on to FF.

In order for pupils to qualify for sixth form, it is expected that they meet 3 of the entrance criteria shown above. Criteria 2 and 3 are essential to enable students to gain a place. If oversubscribed, Criteria 1 will also be a deciding factor in the allocation of pupil places.
